

# CHAPEL SQUARE LANDSCAPE DESIGN

Regent Road, Altrincham

## Key spaces

- ① Chapel Square

  - The development will be set in a high quality landscaped public square to add a much needed town centre green space. The square will promote legibility of the car park entrance and enhance permeability to the town centre retail and medical quarter. Chapel Square will also provide a more fitting commemorative setting for the Chapel Street memorial "the bravest little street in England".
  - The existing surface level parking whilst retained will be reconfigured to allow space for the introduction of a tree lined edge to the car park which will provide a level of screening to the adjacent properties.
- ② Regent Road


  - The proposals will provide funding for the improvements to Regent Road including additional crossing points and upgraded footpaths to match the works already completed within the town centre.
- ③ Pedestrian access to Car park


  - The main car park entrance is designed to separate pedestrian and vehicular access, whilst maximising pedestrian space. This will include a raised crossing to slow vehicle speeds and maintain a dedicated east-west footway into the nearby housing.
- ④ Vehicular access to Car park


  - The existing access from New Street will be retained and improved as the sole vehicular access and egress to the proposed car park and residential properties.
- ⑤ Pedestrian links


  - A number of new pedestrian crossings are proposed to Regent Road. Whilst these will be subject to further design, it is expected that these will match those already present on Stamford New Road.
